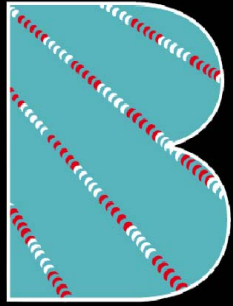
## Rules and Conditions:

- Bramcote Swimming Club's Club Championships will be held under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules. This Meet is level 4 licensed.
- The Meets will be held on Sunday 28th September, Tuesday 30th September, Sunday 12th October and Tuesday 14th October 2008. The venue will be Bramcote Leisure Centre, Derby Road, Nottingham.
- Age as of 31/12/2008.
- Age groups are as follows for the different events (boys and girls):  
100m Individual Medley: 11/under, 13/under, 14/15&16 and 17/over  
50m Freestyle Sprint: 12/over  
200m Freestyle: 13/under  
400m Freestyle: 14/over  
Points events (backstroke, breaststroke, butterfly & freestyle of relevant distances): under 10, under 12, under 14, under 16 and 16/over
- The events swum for points are as follows (boys and girls):  
Under 10: 25m on all strokes  
Under 12: 50m on all strokes, with the exception of butterfly which is swum over 25m  
Under 14: 100m on all strokes, with the exception of butterfly which is swum over 50m  
Under 16: 100m on all strokes  
16/over: 100m on all strokes
- Points will be awarded for the finalists of these events only. There are 6 places available in finals and these places will be awarded to the fastest 6 swimmers from the heats. Points for finalists will be awarded as follows:  
1<sup>st</sup> place = 6, 2<sup>nd</sup> place = 5, 3<sup>rd</sup> place = 4 etc. No points will be awarded if a swimmer is disqualified in the final.
- Awards will be presented at the annual presentation night. Awards will be presented to all finalists and to the three fastest swimmers in the events with heat declared winners.
- The pool length is 25m, six lanes. The pool will be equipped with anti-wave lane ropes. Depth at the deep end is 11'6"; depth at the shallow end is 4'6".
- Heats of all events will be swum within the stated age groups and will be seeded by entry times provided by the club. If a swimmer does not have an entry time, they will be seeded with no time. The 100m Individual Medley, 200m Freestyle and 400m Freestyle will be heat declared winners.
- Overhead starts may be used at the Promoters discretion.
- Entries must be made on the official form (photocopies accepted) and must include the required details together with the correct fees – cheques payable to Bramcote Swimming Club.**

**No individual entries will be accepted after the closing date of 30<sup>th</sup> August 2008.**

- Entries may be held on a computer solely for the purposes of this competition and consent, as required by the Data Protection Act 1984, to the holding of personal information on computer will be deemed to have been given by the submission of the entry. Personal Data will be available for inspection during the meet on application to the Club.
- Warm up will be 20 minutes for all sessions.
- The entry fee is £5 for the championships. This payment of this fee will automatically enter the swimmer into all events that they are eligible for within the championships.
- This meet will be a cardless meet. Details confirming the events entered for all accepted swimmers will be sent out approximately two weeks before the event.
- Swimmers will be called up to two events prior to their swim and should report to the Competitors Steward immediately. The Stewards will send the swimmers to the starting area.
- All participants must observe safety procedures in operation at Bramcote Leisure Centre. Swimmers must wear appropriate footwear when leaving the poolside.
- You are advised not to leave clothing or other articles unattended as neither the Promoter nor the Pool management are able to accept any responsibility for loss or damage.
- By competing in the Meet, you are agreeing to photography taking place. An official photographer may be in attendance, however, anyone wishing to use cameras, video recorders or camera phones should complete the register at the entry desk. Any concerns about photography should be raised with the meet manager.
- Any conditions not covered by this information will be at the discretion of the **Bramcote Swimming Club**
